TRANSPORT INFORMATION

- **STRATHFIELD STATION:**
FREE bus service leaves Strathfield Station (Everton Rd) to Rosehill Gardens. Route 123 at 10.00am then every 30 mins
RETURN SERVICE from Rosehill Gardens (Oak Street) at 3pm to Strathfield Station every 30 mins until 7.00pm (last bus).
- **PARRAMATTA STATION/ WHARF:**
FREE bus service leaves Parramatta Station (Station St) every hour from 9.40 collecting from Charles St Wharf in time with the ferry
RETURN SERVICE from Rosehill Gardens (Oak St) at 2.10, 3.40, 4.40, 5.45pm to Parramatta Wharf (Charles St) onto Parramatta Station
- **COACH AND MINI BUS** parking will be located at Unwin St Gate 2 entry (note there are limited spaces. No bus will be able to deliver or collect from Members P1 or Public P4/P5).
- **TRAINS** will operate a shuttle to and from the Rosehill station arrive and depart every 20 minutes from 9.50am to 7.40pm to Clyde Station.
- **DIRECT TRAIN** from Central, Redfern, Strathfield, then Rosehill and return. (Depart 10.50 & 11.30am Return 5.30 & 6.00pm).

RESTRICTIONS

Sydney Turf Club practice Responsible Service of Alcohol, which includes not allowing patrons to become intoxicated, violent or quarrelsome and not serving patrons under the age of 18 years. In doing so we do not permit bucks parties / football trips away or other large groups of male's access to course.

Patrons AGED between 18 and 25 years of age must obtain an age verification wrist band before they can purchase or consume alcohol on these premises. Alcohol will not be served to young patrons at bars until an age verification wrist band is obtained from Age Verification outlets inside the venue.

Bars sell light beer and soft drink only until 1 hour before the first Sydney race. Drink service during the day is limited to 4 alcoholic drinks per person, after Sydney race 4, 2 alcoholic drinks per person.

Patrons may bring in food items for their own personal consumption.

This includes items such as fruits and single sandwiches and individual pieces

of cake, no bulk perishable or processed items like chickens, meats and seafood is allowed. Alcohol is not permitted onto course. Bag searches are conducted prior to entry by security.
